Application Instructions

How to apply for admission

You may apply for admission to the Augsburg College Master of Arts in Leadership program if you have received a bachelor's degree or higher from a regionally accredited college or university. You may apply for admission to the Post-Master's certificate program if you have received a master's degree from a regionally accredited college or university. Selection of students is based on demonstrated academic ability with satisfactory performance on college work.

Application

Complete our application at www.augsburg.edu/mal. The application fee is waived for all online applications. Contact the Graduate Admission Office at 612-330-1101 if you prefer a paper application.

Transcripts

Have official academic transcripts from all previously attended post-secondary institutions sent directly to the Graduate Admissions Office. This includes colleges, universities, and vocational/technical institutions.

Recommendations

Ask for a recommendation (use enclosed form) to be sent to the Graduate Studies Admission office from each of the following:

- Immediate supervisor—assessing your leadership potential
- Co-worker (at the same level)—describing your work style and potential as a leader

Personal Statement

Submit a written statement relating your career and life goals, focusing on leadership aspiration, and describing how you anticipate the Master of Arts in Leadership will facilitate your development. Minimum of 500 words, typed and double spaced.

Registration

You will be notified of the admission decision after your application file is complete and has been evaluated by the Admissions Committee. After acceptance into the program, you will meet with the program director to register for courses.
