Augsburg Experience Mission: The Augsburg Experience provides a unique signature element and adds value to an Augsburg education by building on theory from the classroom and expanding the student's learning beyond the campus.

Overall AugEx Criteria (Faculty approved April 10, 2002)

1. The Augsburg Experience integrates experiential learning with academic learning. It demonstrates enhanced learning and reflects research and best practices of experiential education.
2. An Augsburg Experience links on-campus learning to the constituency goals, mission, needs or ideas of off-campus people, organizations, and/or communities, through community partners and/or professional activities and/ or travel.

Course Embedded AugEx Guidelines:

1. The Augsburg Experience typically will be a part of an upper division course and completed by Juniors or Seniors
2. The Augsburg Experience expectations should be clearly stated in the course syllabus and the activities/reflection should be integrated throughout the course.
3. Structured reflection is expected which links the Augsburg Experience to the students' major(s) and Augsburg's core curriculum goals.
4. Twenty percent (20%) of the course should be devoted to the Augsburg Experience which includes a combination of: the hours students spent at the **off-campus** organization(s) and site(s), associated assignments, guided reflection and discussion on the experience, and other related activities.
