# Bible, Christian theology and vocation in **MEXICO**

### About the Program

Learn about the tremendous influence different theological perspectives have had on social change in Latin America. The course will focus on the Bible as articulated by prominent theologians, and upon the concept of vocation, as articulated by local church activists in Mexico. Students will have the opportunity to deepen their appreciation of religious values and theological concepts which differ from their own.
