# 2009 AP\* Summer Institute

## Cost

The cost for the AP\* Summer Institute is \$700 for a full week. It covers workshop instruction, graduate tuition, materials, snacks, and lunch. The total registration fee is required at the time of registration in order to be confirmed. Graduate credit is covered by the registration fee. See the cancellation policy on the registration form.

## Room and Board

On-campus housing is limited and will be allocated on a first-come, first-served basis. A fee of \$350 covers the cost of housing in a campus dormitory, plus breakfast and dinner. Housing is provided for four nights from Sunday through Wednesday.

## Credit and Accreditation

Each workshop carries two graduate semester credits or three continuing education units. Your registration fee covers the tuition. Graduate credit will be recorded as 0.5 Augsburg graduate credits (equivalent to two semester credits or three quarter credits).

Augsburg College is a four-year college of liberal arts and science, located in the heart of Minneapolis, and a college of the ELCA. Augsburg is accredited by the Higher Learning Commission of the North Central Association; the Education Department is NCATE-accredited and the institute is College Board\*-endorsed.

Enrollment is limited, with registrations accepted in the order received.

The registration deadline is **May 15, 2009**.

*Registrations received after May 15 will be charged a \$25 late fee.*
