Fine Arts Scholarship Application

The Fine Arts Scholarship in Film is awarded by Augsburg film faculty to incoming first-year and transfer students who have excelled in film production and demonstrate exceptional potential in film.

The award is worth \$3,000 per year and is renewable for four years.



To be considered for a Fine Arts Scholarship in Film, applicants must:

Complete and return the Fine Arts Scholarship application including the **application form, film résumé, teacher recommendation, and film/video reel on DVD** postmarked by November 1, 2009 for spring semester; January 25, 2010 for fall semester. Submit a **film/video reel on DVD** that is an example of your best work. It should not be longer than 15 minutes.

You will be contacted to schedule an interview only after you have been admitted to Augsburg College and Admissions has received your completed Fine Arts Scholarship Application. For students entering Spring 09-10, interviews will be scheduled by appointment. For students entering Fall 10-11, interviews will be held during scholarship weekend, February 19-20, 2010.
