Application Instructions

Admission Requirements

Candidates admissible into the Master of Arts in Education program have earned:

- A baccalaureate degree from a regionally-accredited college or university
- A cumulative grade point average of 3.0 (on a scale of A = 4.0) in existing undergraduate or graduate coursework.

Applicants with a cumulative grade point average between 2.5 and 2.9 may apply to be admitted conditionally. Applicants who have a cumulative grade point average below 2.5 may be initially admitted at an undergraduate level.

Note: Prospective students who are interested in completing a bachelor's degree or teachers who would like to earn a license at the undergraduate level without pursuing a master's degree should contact Weekend College Admissions at 612-330-1001 or wecinfo@augsborg.edu for more information and a different application.

Information Session

Candidates for the MAE program must attend an information session or make a personal appointment with the Graduate Admissions Office at 612-330-1520 to review the details of the license requirements and master's degree.

Application

Complete our online MAE application at www.augsburg.edu/mae/admissions. The application fee of \$35 is waived for all online applications. Contact the Graduate Admissions Office at 612-330-1101 or gradinfo@augsborg.edu if you prefer a paper application.

Transcripts

Have two official academic transcripts from all previously attended post-secondary institutions sent directly to the Graduate Admissions Office. This includes colleges, universities, and vocational/technical institutions. We must have a transcript with your undergraduate degree noted in order to complete your application.

Personal statement

Submit a written statement relating your career and life goals, focusing on your desire to teach, and describing how the MAE program will help you reach your goals. Minimum of 500 words, typed, and double spaced.

Advising and Registration

You will be notified of the admission decision after your application file is complete and has been evaluated by the Graduate Admissions Committee. All students in the Master of Arts in Education and related initial licensure programs are required to be advised by a faculty member before registration the first term, and as needed thereafter. You may register for courses once you have been accepted into the program and advised.
