Approved Courses for Social Work

For students planning to transfer to Augsburg College and major in Social Work, the following departmental equivalencies are provided. This guide is intended as a supplement to Augsburg's transfer guide available in your college's counseling office or online at <http://www.augsburg.edu/registrar/transfer.html>

The Social Work major consists of seven supporting courses and ten upper-division SWK courses at Augsburg. The table below indicates which supporting courses may be completed at Century College. No equivalencies are available for the upper-division SWK major courses.

*HSER 1020 and HSER 2780 must be taken concurrently to receive credit for SWK100

*BIOL1024 Human Biology will satisfy the human biology content for the Social Work major. Since it does not have a lab section it is not equivalent to BIO121 Human Biology with Lab at Augsburg. BIOL 1024 is the preferred course for the major.
