**Advising Information**

It is recommended that most liberal arts courses be taken before starting the nursing major at Augsburg. Augsburg strongly encourages students to complete MCTC coursework that fulfills the Entry-level Mathematics Skill requirement, at least one Lifetime Fitness requirement, and at least one Fine Arts requirement. Students should consult Augsburg's *Transfer Guide*.

**Keep in mind:**

- Students may transfer up to 64 semester credits (16 course credits) of liberal arts coursework from two-year institutions.
- Students will receive a block grant of 24 semester credits (6 course credits) for their nursing courses upon completion of the associate degree in nursing.
- Any course with a grade below C will not be accepted in transfer.

- No individual nursing courses at MCTC can substitute for courses in the nursing major at Augsburg.
- A cumulative GPA of 2.5 or higher in the nursing program is required for admittance to Augsburg's nursing major.
