Pass/NoPass Grading policy:

(November 16, 2005)

In general, students are expected to take most of their courses while earning traditional grades. Pass/No Pass grades are offered with certain restrictions. There are both general restrictions applying to:

- all students
- specific restrictions applying to those who wish to earn college and/or departmental honors upon graduation.

All students earning an undergraduate degree in Social Work (BSW) at Augsburg College must take the field work and integrative seminar courses as Pass/No Pass. These courses do not count against the College limit of a total of 6 P/N courses.

Because the 4 field work/integrative seminar courses in the social work major are offered as P/N courses only, they do not count against the college limit of 6 P/N courses.

Therefore, social work majors are able to earn up to **10 P/N credits** with 6 P/N credits from the general education, supporting courses, and/or elective course offerings. Social work majors cannot take core Social Work courses for P/N (SWK 301 or higher).

Students wishing to earn college honors can take up to 2 P/N courses total, and must complete a minimum of 14 traditionally graded credits. Students wishing to earn departmental honors can take up to 2 traditionally graded courses as P/N and complete a minimum of 14 traditionally graded courses.
