ABOUT THE PROGRAM

TRIO/Student Support Services (TRIO/SSS) is funded by the U.S. Department of Education and Augsburg College. TRIO/SSS is committed to helping **low-income, first-generation college students and students with disabilities** achieve a bachelor's degree. The program's mission is to increase retention and graduation rates by offering academic and personal support.

The TRIO/SSS Summer Bridge five-week academic program assists 20 incoming students with their transition to Augsburg College through two free college courses.

During the academic year, TRIO/SSS students receive individual and group advising to foster positive study habits and academic success. Students can take advantage of a comfortable learning environment, financial counseling, leadership opportunities, cultural excursions, and exciting academic workshops. There is no cost of participation for the student.

Ask about the TRIO/SSS Scholarship!

Active participants in TRIO/SSS with Pell grants are eligible to apply.

PROGRAM ELIGIBILITY

Federal regulations require that the participants be at least one of the following:

- ▼ **low-income student** (family meets Federal Income Eligibility Guidelines, as verified by Augsburg College)
- ▼ **first-generation college student** (signifies that neither custodial parent/guardian has graduated from a four-year institution at the time of student's enrollment)
- ▼ **college student with documented disabilities**

In addition, TRIO/SSS participants must be:

- ▼ **undergraduate** students;
- ▼ **U.S. citizens, permanent residents, or refugees;**
- ▼ students with **academic need;** and
- ▼ students with **commitment to succeed in college.**

PROGRAM SERVICES

From enrollment until graduation, TRIO/SSS students may receive assistance in the following areas:
