UNDERGRADUATE ADMISSION PROCESS

All students must apply to the College, and be admitted, prior to registering for any classes.

To be considered for admission, students must submit:

- Completed application form
- Completed personal statement (typed, approximately 200 words in length)
- All official college/university/technical transcripts (transcripts are considered official only if they arrive in our office in sealed envelopes from the institution)
- High school transcript or GED certificate (if transferring less than one year of college credit).

All applicants must have the equivalent of a high school degree to meet the minimum application requirements. No minimum college course credits are required for admission to Augsburg College undergraduate programs—with the exception of the BSN completion program, which requires a two-year RN degree prior to admission.

The admissions board will review applications for admission and contact the applicant within **one week** of file completion. New students then meet with an academic adviser to create their education plan, complete any assessment tests required, and register for classes. Online registration is open to current students only.

Coursework completed outside of the United States may require further documentation. If English is not a student's first language, additional testing and assessments may be required. Please contact an admissions counselor for details if either situation pertains to you.

INFORMATION FOR TRANSFER STUDENTS

General guidelines for transfer credit:

- Augsburg College accepts transfer credits from regionally accredited institutions.
- Coursework may be accepted if it applies to general liberal arts or major requirements.
- Transferable coursework must be graded at a C or higher.
- College transcripts are required from every university, college, and technical school regardless of transferability of coursework.

To arrange an individual appointment for unofficial transcript evaluations, contact an admissions counselor. Upon admission to the College, an official transcript evaluation will be completed by the registrar's office and mailed directly to the student.

Transfer Credit Standing:

Freshmen – fewer than 7 Augsburg course credits completed
Sophomores – 7 or more Augsburg course credits completed
Juniors – 16 or more Augsburg course credits completed
Seniors – 24 or more Augsburg course credits completed
Graduation – minimum of 32 Augsburg course credits completed

Note: At Augsburg one course equals one “Augsburg” credit. Each Augsburg credit/course equals four semester credits or six quarter credits. For example, a bachelor's degree at a university typically requires 128 semester credits; at Augsburg a bachelor's degree requires 32 Augsburg credits.

A minimum of nine Augsburg credits/courses (seven of the last nine requirements must be completed at Augsburg) are required to receive a bachelor's degree from Augsburg College. Contact an admissions counselor for specific degree information.
